## THE U EXPANDS CHICAGO HIGH SCHOOL BASKETBALL BROADCASTING COMMITMENT

## GAME OF THE WEEK | IHSA CHAMPIONSHIPS | CPS CHAMPIONSHIPS

This season's schedule features nine schools in the Chicago Sun-Times Super 25 along with top prep players like Ahron Ulis from Marian Catholic, Adam Miller at Morgan Park and Bryce Hopkins of Fenwick. Duke University recruit Patrick Baldwin Jr. is also featured when his school, Wisconsin's top Division I ranked team, Sussex Hamilton, takes on Sun-Times #2 ranked Evanston on Saturday, February 8.
